



Directions to **The Willows Bed and Breakfast** – Horton in Ribblesdale

GPS Coordinates Lat: 54:08:59N - Lon: 2:18:03W + **OS Grid** Reference SD804726

Most of you will approach us from the direction of the A65 between Leeds and Kendal. Coming from the direction of Kendal, you need to leave the A65 and turn left onto the B6480 just a mile or so after Rawlinshaw, a few miles before Settle. Follow the B6480 into Settle and just across the river Ribble turn left onto the B6479 towards Horton-in-Ribblesdale. Follow the B6480 for about 6 miles.

From the direction of Leeds and Skipton - After Long Preston village carry on a few miles and you will go under a railway bridge. Just after that you will come to a roundabout. Turn right towards Settle – sign posted Horton-in-Ribblesdale. Travel through Settle and traffic lights, look out for a Horton-in-Ribblesdale signpost on your right. Just before the bridge over the river Ribble you need to turn right onto the B6479 towards Horton-in-Ribblesdale. Follow the B6479 for about 6 miles.

As you enter our village on the B6479, you will see a large rock on your left hand side with 'Horton-in-Ribblesdale' carved into it, with a church on your right.

Continue around a right hand bend and through the village past Pen-y-ghent cafe on left hand side, then over two humpback bridges at Crown pub. Follow painted white sign on 2nd bridge to 'Hawes'.

The main road will turn right just before the railway station. Follow the road and the signs for Hawes /Ribbleshead. After approx 100 yards look left for a green painted Victorian lamppost in our garden.

The Willows B&B is the 3rd driveway and house on your left - we have a shared driveway - slightly past our house, with an open field at the front on your right. Enter our sloped drive and turn left. The Willows has a tree in the garden – the house on the left with the white limestone driveway. There is parking for several cars if we all park carefully.

If you are approaching us along the B6479 from the North, The Willows is on your right, opposite a field, about 300 yards after the railway bridge and before you reach Horton railway station. (If arriving by train, take a left at the junction. The Willows is on your left after about 100 yards)
